

Waltham Liquor Licensees

Both Bentley University and Brandeis University staff will verify whether a student presenting an identification to purchase liquor or enter an establishment is age 21 or over.

Simply call their police business line, identify who you are and your purpose of the call. Inform the dispatcher the student's name and date of birth on the state identification provided. The dispatcher will verify whether the date of birth is accurate or not.

1) WHEN PRESENTED WITH FALSE IDENTIFICATION:

- 1) Confiscate the false identification card used;
- 2) Call Waltham Police Operations @ (781) 314 3607, we will send an officer by to retrieve the false identification and submit a report; or
- 2) Keep the identification and drop it off at the police station or mail it to the address below at your earliest convenience; or
- 2) At the end of each month contact Detective Lieutenant Brian E. Lambert's Office @ (781) 314 3568 and he or a designee will collect the identification(s) confiscated or simply mail them to the following address:

2) INTOXICATED PATRON

If an intoxicated patron refuses assistance with getting home safely, and insists on driving, staff should **call 9-1-1 immediately**.

If the intoxicated person enters his or her vehicle and drives away and only if it is safe to do so, obtain the vehicle's license plate information, car description (color, make and model) and last known direction of travel. Communicate this information to the responding officers.

3) FIGHT

If there is a fight in your establishment **CALL 9-1-1 IMMEDIATELY**. Liquor Licensees are **required** to contact the Waltham police when a fight or other disturbance occurs in their establishment.
